- 2. INTERNATIONAL ARTISTS CAN SEND PRINTS ASLO BUT IT SHOULD BE DULY SIGNED IN ORIGINAL AS A MARK OF AUTHENTICITY.
- 3. Each entry must be authentic, original work of participating artist.
- 4. ART WORK SUBMISSION DETAILS:
 - Paintings and Sculptures can be of any medium
 - TOTAL 2 ARTWORKS PER ENTRY WILL BE ALLOWED.
 - Arts / Sculptures Pottery etc should not be older than 2020.
 - Every artwork should bear a Title, Year, Dimension, Medium, Price and a short Story / Description of the Paintings.
 - Size of Paintings should not exceed 36 inches X 36 Inches.
 - PREFERRED SIZE of Sculptures / Pottery / Ceramics is 24 inches X 24 inches and height not more than 36 inches.
- 5. Images of art works submitted for registration should be of higher resolution in JPEG / PNG format for catalogue.

- 7. Last Date of Registration 31.12.2022
- 8. Art works / prints couriered from other states / countries should reach us between 15th and 25th January 2023.
- 9. Art works to be couriered at the following Address: will be informed in DECEMBER.
- 10. Artworks that are couriered SHOULD NOT HAVE ANY GLASS COVERING instead fibre can be used.
- 11. Artworks that needs to be stretched / framed at the venue will be charged at actuals.
- 12. Every artwork sold will carry the Letter of authenticity duly signed by the artist.
- 13. All sales will be negotiated by AAF.
- 14. NO COMMISSION WILL BE CHARGED ON ART SALE.
- 15. Space allotted to the participants will be final and will not be changed at any cost.
- 16. All participants are to keep the displayed art works for one month after the end of exhibition (i.e. till 6th March 2022).
- 17. Proper & secured Hotel facility can be provided to selected artists at the cost of Rs. 600 per day (twin sharing basis).
- 18. AAF reserve the right to modify / change / issue new terms / conditions for the efficient and smooth functioning of art fair.
- 19. AAF reserves the right to cancel the participation. if terms & conditions are violated by the participating artists.
- 20. Participants will get their space a day prior to the inaugural date.
- 21. The artists must bear all the costs associated with the transport / courier of their art works to and from the exhibition venue.
- 22. The participant will not be allowed to display exhibits in such a manner, so as to obstruct the light or impede passages or disturb the displays of neighbouring exhibitors.
- 23. Any misbehaviour will result in immediate disqualification.
- 24. The participants shall take utmost care **NOT** to damage floor or structure. The cost of damage, if any, specified by organizers / venue authorities, will have to be borne by the participant immediately.
